## GENERAL NOTICE

### **RE: KENYA LAUNCHES DIGITAL SYSTEM FOR VERIFICATION OF COVID-19 TEST CERTIFICATES**

The Embassy of the Republic of Kenya to the State of Kuwait informs of new guidelines from the Ministry of Health on digital verification of Covid-19 test results for all travelers to the Republic of Kenya in two (2) steps as below:-

#### **STEP 1**

1. "Trusted Travel" is a digital system rolled out by the Ministry of Health (MOH) for verification of COVID-19 tests for all travelers to Kenya through which airlines and Port Health Authorities will be able to validate Covid test results.
2. A person intending to travel to Kenya must visit an authorized laboratory in the country of departure for COVID-19 PCR test and acquire a Covid negative Certificate.
3. The traveler is then required to visit [www.africacds.org/trusted-travel](http://www.africacds.org/trusted-travel) for guidance on uploading the test results.
4. Once the registration is done, all the steps followed and the test Certificate is uploaded, a TT code will be generated for the traveler which one may copy or screenshot and present when requested.

#### **STEP 2**

1. "Jitenge" platform has also been launched by MOH through which all travelers are required to submit online their Travelers Health Surveillance Form before disembarking.
2. The jitenge app can be downloaded from Google Play Store or accessed online by typing "Jitenge MOH" on any browser or through the link [bit.ly/covid19moh](http://bit.ly/covid19moh).
3. Upon registration, the traveler will be issued with a QR code that should be presented to the health desk on arrival. The traveler will also be subjected to self-monitor and report daily on the same platform for fourteen (14) days while in Kenya.

**NB:** All the other Covid-19 measures and quarantine protocols communicated earlier remain in place.
